Golden Rule Update:

Under Disruptive Conduct (h), Any organization found to be participating in any event with a student organization that is currently on disciplinary probation (with restrictive conditions), has been suspended, or has had their UCF registration revoked, will be in violation of the UCF Golden rule. Please be mindful of this new regulation for all student organizations!

Conduct Update

Beta Theta Pi Fraternity: Suspended from UCF for 2 years

Sigma Chi Fraternity: Restricted probation until end of fall 2009 semester, with their only restriction being no IM sports. Disciplinary probation until end of spring 2009, with no restrictions.

Iota Phi Theta Fraternity: Social Probation until end of fall 2009 semester (no social activities allowed for the organization)

Omega Psi Phi Fraternity: Not recognized as a registered student organization until fall 2010.
